

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-06

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND PORTIONS OF SECTION 63-3 OF THE
VILLAGE OF FOX POINT VILLAGE CODE CONCERNING
SWIMMING POOL FEES**

WHEREAS, the Village Manager has requested that certain amendments be made to Section 63-3 of the Village of Fox Point Village Code concerning swimming pool fees, to add a reduced fee for early morning adult swim and to allow the Village Manager some flexibility in the sound financial management of the swimming pool; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Fox Point Village Board finds that the changes proposed by the Village Manager are appropriate and advisable to implement the best management practices at the pool.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Fox Point, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION I Chapter 63 of the Village of Fox Point Village Code entitled, “Fees,” Section 63-3 entitled “Swimming Pool Fees,” Subsection (A) entitled, “Applicable Fees,” the intro language only (with the subsections remaining unchanged) is hereby repealed and re-created as follows:

- A. Applicable fees. The fees to be charged for use of the Village of Fox Point Municipal Swimming Pool shall be as follows, except as described in subsection B:

SECTION II Chapter 63 of the Village of Fox Point Village Code entitled, “Fees,” Section 63-3 entitled “Swimming Pool Fees,” Subsection (16) is hereby created as follows:

- (16) Daily Fee for Adult Swim Between 7:00 am and 8:00 am: \$3

SECTION III Chapter 63 of the Village of Fox Point Village Code entitled, “Fees,” Section 63-3 entitled “Swimming Pool Fees,” Subsection B entitled, “Short Term Fee Adjustments” is hereby created as follows:

- B. Short Term Fee Adjustments. The Village Manager is authorized and empowered to temporarily modify the fees described in Subsection A by increasing or decreasing the fee, or by adding or removing fees, as the Village Manager deems necessary or appropriate in the management of the Fox Point municipal swimming pool. This flexibility is granted in order to timely respond to changing opportunities and needs for the community, to encourage broad participation while minimizing overcrowding, and for sound financial management of the pool facility. Such temporary changes shall be clearly publicized in a manner designed

to give notice to the public. Such temporary changes shall remain in effect for no longer than the remainder of the calendar year in which they are first created.


SECTION IV SEVERABILITY.

The several sections of this Ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or provision thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful, or unenforceable, such declaration shall apply only to the specific section(s) or portion(s) thereof directly specified in said declaration, and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections, or portions of the Ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect. Any other Ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

SECTION V EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect following its passage and publication or posting as provided by law.
